- **Economic Development:**

Connect more than 1,000 people to jobs each year, and create jobs in low-income neighborhoods through business loans and development

- **Education and Youth Development:**

Provide academic assistance, counseling, community service opportunities, literacy classes, tutoring, internships and employment to school-aged children and young adults

- **Family Support:**

Offer refugees resettlement, parenting education, family mediation and counseling for those struggling with domestic violence or at risk of foster care placement

- **Health:**

Promote nutrition, wellness and disease prevention. Provide a complete range of services for individuals and families affected by HIV/AIDS and other chronic illnesses.

- **Housing:**

Prevent homelessness and provide, emergency, transitional and permanent housing. **CAMBA Housing Ventures** builds sustainable and affordable supportive apartments for low-income and formerly homeless New Yorkers.

- **Legal Services:**

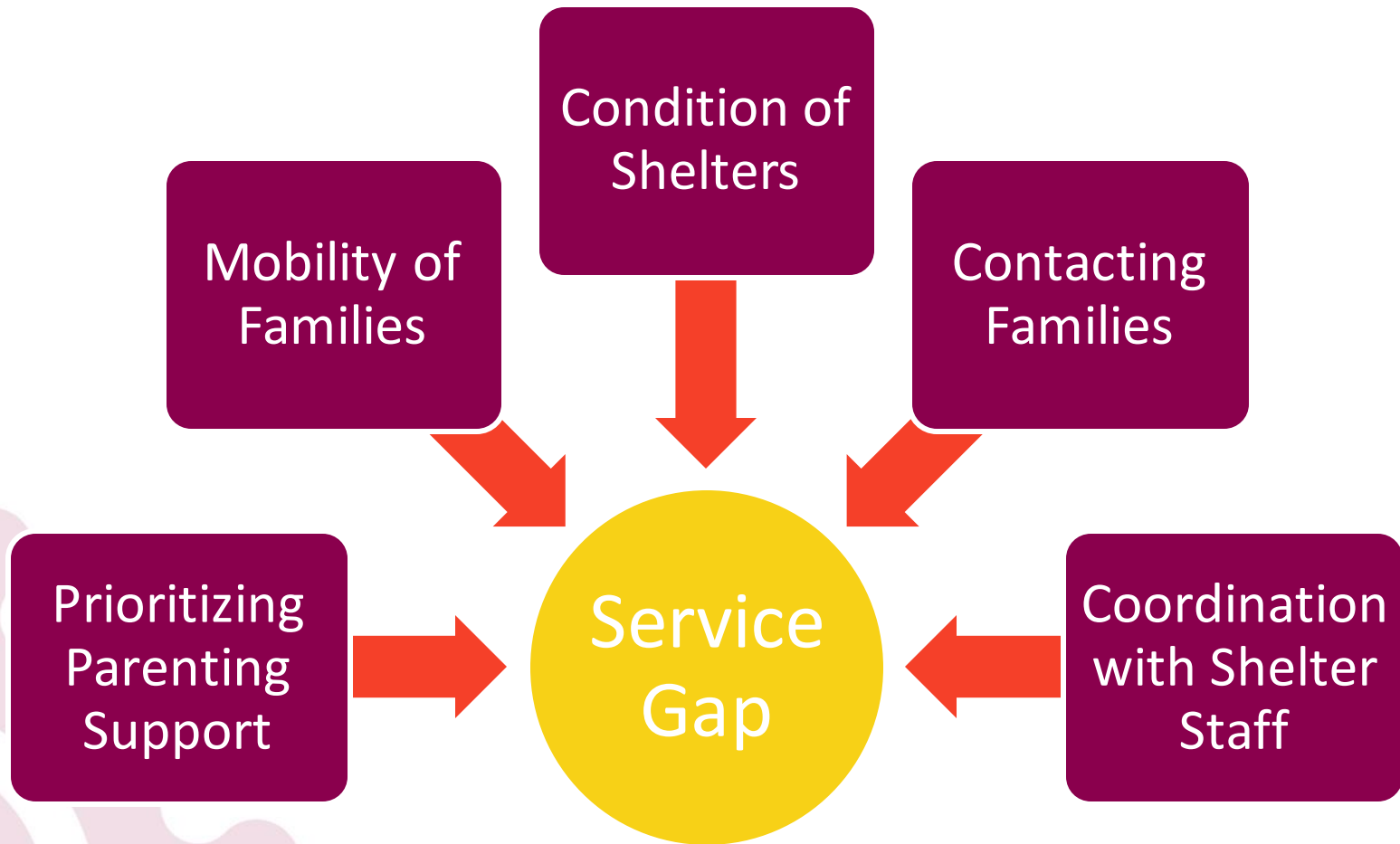
Represent and advise low-income New Yorkers on housing, immigration, consumer finance, domestic violence, and foreclosure prevention.
